


ACCOUNTABILITY STATEMENT

COMMENT ON RESULTS

We are proud to report that we have maintained our excellence in instruction practices and character development as well as continuing to increase the quality of education for our students. At the same time, our preparation of students for the world of work has improved. Parental involvement was reported to have increased from 'Intermediate' in 2019 to 'Very High' in 2020.

Our plans to increase the breadth of our programs of study were interrupted by the global COVID-19 pandemic. We will implement those changes as soon as conditions allow.

The cancellation of the 2020 writing of Provincial Achievement Tests resulted in limited data regarding student achievement

100% agree students are being prepared for the workforce.

100% of students report their teacher care about them.

94% of students report their school has stayed the same or improved.

STRATEGIES

The COVID-19 pandemic halted our planned initiatives to broaden the programs of study within Greentree School.

INITIATIVE #1

To develop digital literacy of our students, we created an innovation center. We obtained grant funds to install a plethora of quality digital items including 3D printers, GoPro cameras, Chromebox computers, a green screen wall and licenses for online video editing software. All Greentree students will be provided opportunities to use of these digital tools throughout the school year.

95.8% of parents, students, and teachers are satisfied with the quality of education.



INITIATIVE #2

We have plans to implement two academies, offered to students in grades four through six. The first two academies will focus on drama and band. We will develop skills of students through semester-long intensive classes.

For future academies, we will work with local businesses and experts to further enhance learning opportunities for our students. Some possible offerings will include golf, sculpture, water colour painting, dance, and various other programs of interest to our students and families.

FACILITY AND CAPITAL

We continue to improve our building and site at Greentree School. All classroom doors were painted in the spring of 2020. Also, the school sign at the front entrance was repainted as were the flag poles.

Over the summer, the chain link fence was extended to provide further protection to our playground area.

In the fall of 2020, new windows were installed in three classrooms; more window replacements are planned for the upcoming year.
