

Greentree School is a Pre-Kindergarten to Grade 6 school with a population of approximately 350 students.


Students are divided into two traditional grade-level classrooms each, with the addition of one classroom with both kindergarten and grade one students.

Our alternative classrooms (Pre-K, Achieving Independence and Strive) support students with diverse academic, social-emotional, and self-regulation needs.

We have been excited to add academy opportunities for our students to learn beyond regular classroom programming.

We are proud to develop our athletics programs further this year. Students can participate in Mini Dynos, Junior Dynos, and a Greentree Junior Dragons Hockey Academy. These all enhance the experience of our students.

Greentree School infuses powerful learning in thinking classrooms. We are collaborative, supportive, and welcoming. We are always excited about opportunities to enhance our school community. Greentree will be creative in ways to strengthen the connections between all stakeholders.

Our Community Stakeholders

Greentree School's parents are welcome and encouraged to participate in our School Council. It is an essential part of our school community. At their monthly meetings, council members connect Greentree School to the Drumheller community stakeholders to enhance our students' experiences. The school council has an impact giving voice to the budget and programming of our school, and providing feedback about new initiatives and reviewing existing practices.

This past year, our grade five students worked with a grade three class to have trees planted on school grounds. The grade five class worked through an inquiry project that included a presentation to the Drumheller Town Council. They were granted 30 trees to beautify our field and playground.






Every Student is Successful


Grade 6 PAT Results


Strategies











Our Results


Literacy and Numeracy Success for all Learners

School Strategies

Greentree School, as part of Golden Hills School Division, will continue to offer Early intervention programs to provide a strong foundation for literacy and numeracy skill development. To help classroom teachers support learners, we have weekly Resource Team Meetings where our counsellor, administration, teachers, and school consultant, a registered psychologist, meet to discuss how best to support each student, including involving wrap-around services where necessary. There are two alternative classroom options for students who struggle in a traditional setting: Strive and Achieving Independence. This year, after recognizing the increasing mental health concerns of students, we have increased our counselling availability to full-time.

Facilities and Capital Plan


We continue to improve our building and site at Greentree School to increase efficiency as well as create a more welcoming and safe environment.

Chairs were purchased by our School Council, to improve the comfort of guests at school events. Greentree School Council also replenished the wood chips in our playground.

An accessibility door has been installed in our front entrance to ensure all students, with ranging mobility levels, can feel welcome and easily enter our school.

Trees, donated from the Town of Drumheller, were planted in collaboration with an inquiry project with our grade 5 and grade 3 teachers, Molly Moar and Megan Mason, and their students.

We anticipate playground climbers to be installed in our field to ease playground congestion and provide students with more opportunities for enjoyment and play.
